

## The Chicken Tree Quilt

‘one of a kind’ hand dyed fabrics by--- *The Chicken Tree*

Approximate size of finished quilt is  
38 1/2" x 38 1/2"

Instructions and actual size pattern included

Skill level—intermediate to advanced

### FABRIC Needed

4 different colors of 1 Yard pieces of “one of a kind” hand dyed fabric  
(more if you want) 100% cotton

### Supplies needed

Basic Sewing Supplies

Freezer Paper

White Clover Marking pen or marker of your choice

Design Wall (optional), but very helpful when cutting pieces,  
placement

Light box or other light source

Sticky notes

This is not a difficult quilt to make. If you have never sewn curves before, consider it a learning experience. When using “one of a kind” hand dyed fabric, the color selection, placement of color, placement of pattern pieces on ‘interesting areas’ within the fabric, along with the quilting design(s) you chose will make this YOUR quilt.

Remember you are working with ‘one of a kind’ hand dyed fabric—you won’t find it again, it’s unique.

The most important thing is to have fun, enjoy the experience. The only straight line you will sew on this quilt is the binding.

Before you begin cutting your fabric, please read the instructions.
